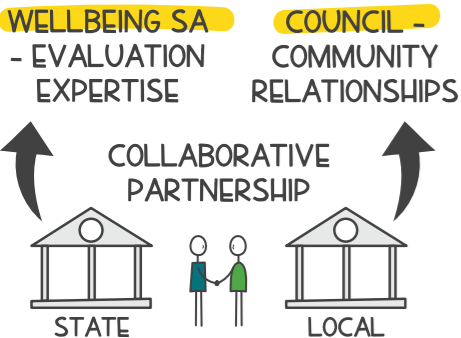


WHAT WORKED REALLY WELL?

STRONG ANECDOTAL EVIDENCE - SOCIAL ASPECT MOST IMPORTANT PART OF THE GARDEN

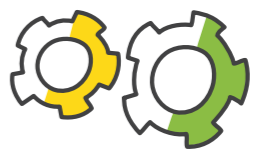
INITIAL PROPOSAL CHANGED TO PROTECT COMMUNITY WELL-BEING

WELLBEING SA GOAL - NOT SO MUCH COUNCIL

YES TO EVALUATE ACCESSIBILITY & IMPACT OF THE GARDEN

THOUGHTS ON SUCCESS

LENGTH OF GARDEN PROJECT LIKELY INFLUENCE ON SUCCESS

SHORT TERM PROJECTS MAY LACK RELATIONSHIPS THAT SUPPORT PARTICIPATION

PARTICIPANTS WERE A STEP REMOVED - NOT SHARING PERSONAL INFORMATION

QUALITATIVE DATA COLLECTION - ASKING AND LETTING THEM ANSWER ALONE

BROADNESS QUESTIONS GAVE A LOT MORE DEPTH

RECRUITMENT WAS CASUAL - SMALL AUDIENCE MADE IT EASY

MAYBE INVOLVE WORKERS AND COMMUNITY MORE IN THE COLLECTION DESIGN

LESSONS LEARNED

MORE TIME NEEDED TO TRAIN - MORE RESOURCES

USING TECHNOLOGY - BALANCE RESPECTING THEIR TIME & MAKING THEM PREPARED

NEEDS PROJECTS WITH ESTABLISHED RELATIONSHIPS

BE CLEVER IN TECHNOLOGY

DATA MGMT TAKES A WHILE WHEN QUALITATIVE
