Move from professional Scientists to **volunteers/community**

Creating new insights - access to things you **can't produce** on your own

Co-created projects - communities involved from the start

Helping to **analyse** the data

Crowd sourced **data collection**

USING CITIZEN SCIENCE

Only 7 of 615 citizen science projects focused on health
Opinions, diversity, perceptions etc.

Collect more data
Richer data
Cheaper data

OUR PROJECTS

Train them and have them collect data about **their own neighbourhoods** in their everyday life

Allows us to capture **MORE** details

Started in February - so lockdown impacted

Recruited 93 - using **local governments**

You find us volunteers, we'll report your area

We use **ESRI tool** - geo-location of collection

Real-time data - time and date stamped

Less than 7 minutes to complete

Daily tracking allows us to remind them when engagement drops off

What they **like** and what they **don't like** - good to feedback to LGAs

Including ability to say **resident or non-resident**

Linking walks or doing errands with green spaces - walking through the park to get to the bus

WHERE TO FROM HERE?

Co-designing a survey for age friendly communities - to be used internationally

Smartphone is a **game changer** - people prefer to use it

Training is **essential** - you can't ignore it & good to give options

Cheatsheet to help Support, check-in, **ongoing**

Oh yeah, I should be collecting

COVID gave some interesting data - more dog walking, exercise and connecting with nature

CITIZEN SCIENCE FOR GREENER, HEALTHIER NEIGHBOURHOODS

Trying to create sources - Citizen Science as a method of **life-long learning**

We ask if they want to be contacted for **future projects** - most say yes

Do you recruit only for specific projects?

Does it work with partners wanting quick projects?

Pilots have all been short and cheap

Better to **not be collecting** for too long anyway

Consider **seasonal** pockets of collection

QUESTIONS

How do you get ethics approval to co-design?

Helped that we had **previous examples** and type of tool

They're **more interested** in the selection and engagement of people over the questions

They've asked for the ability to **engage more** with each other

They get a copy of the report - **involved all the way**
